


IN CASE OF AN

- 
- Stop and place emergency warning devices.
 - Assess the situation:
Are there immediate dangers?
Is anyone hurt?
 - Move victims carefully, and only if safety demands it.
 - Give first aid as needed.
 - Call for help, or see to it that someone else does. Give details on injuries and hazards to operator or emergency dispatcher.
 - Get names and addresses of all drivers involved in the accident.
 - If commercial vehicles are involved, get company names and addresses.
 - Write down the names of witnesses.
 - Make a written record of the circumstances. Sketch a diagram.
 - Avoid any discussion about who is at fault.
 - Report the accident to your company as soon as possible.
